Our dental program currently provides full services for the following high risk populations including:

- Children.
- Pregnant women, patients with poorly controlled diabetes, patients who have HIV, or are receiving radiation therapy and/ or chemotherapy for cancer, or patients who are preparing for organ transplant or prosthetic joint replacement.
- Patients with other medical conditions referred by a Rural Health medical provider.

Additionally patients of recently retired local dentists are seen as space allows.

Emergency care is available for all Eastern Shore of VA residents.
